Warehouse Flow

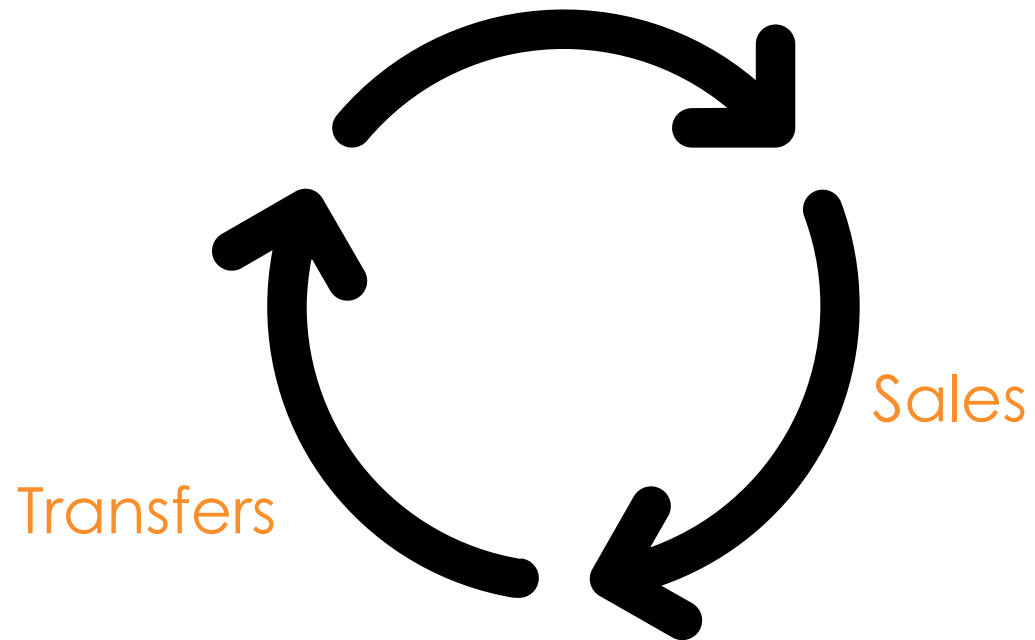
Complexity level defines the warehouse flow.

- Advanced Warehousing

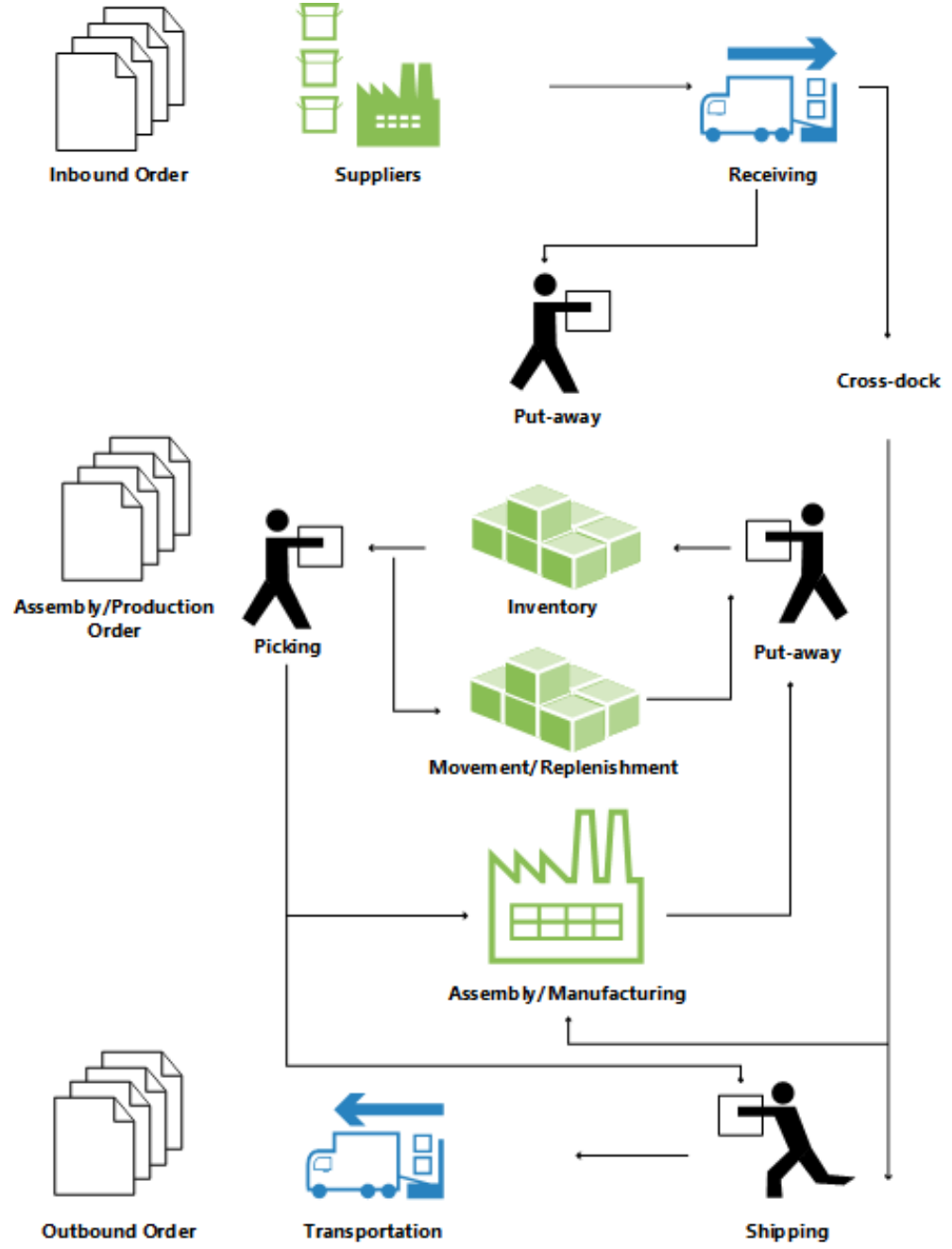

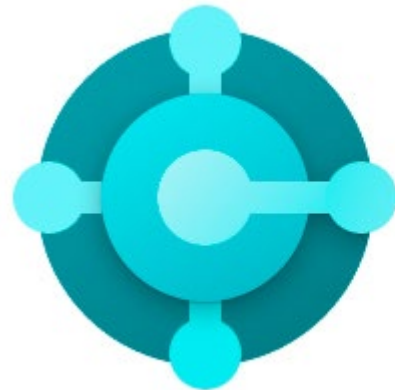
Notification

Headaches and Pain Points

- ✓ No visibility
- ✓ No planning ability
- ✓ Difficult inventory allocation



Pro-tip: Dates!!

- ✓ Dates *MUST* be managed on all documents to allow for a better flow within the warehouse.
 - ✓ If dates are not maintained, receiving will not know when to expect materials
 - ✓ Pickers/packers/shippers will not have a good understanding of order urgency.
 - ✓ Sales cannot set realistic expectations for customers

Visibility

- ✓ Item Ledger Entries
- ✓ Warehouse Entries
- ✓ Bin Contents
- ✓ Reservations



Opportunities for Improvement

- ✓ Multi-document printing
- ✓ Smart use of filter/sort/print
 - ✓ Carrier
 - ✓ Customer Priority
 - ✓ Stock Availability
- ✓ Shipping
